### The Flower Cup

- 29: A vase of garden flowers

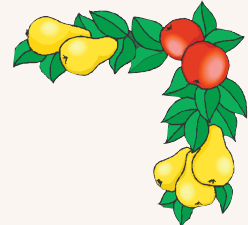
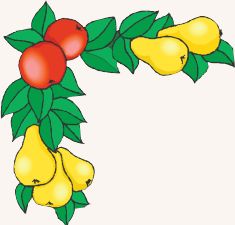


## SECTION 3: COUNTRYSIDE SECTION

### The Corvedale Shield

- 33: Jar of homemade jam or marmalade
- 34: Jar of Lemon Curd
- 35: Jar of homemade chutney
- 36: Homemade beverage (alcoholic or non-alcoholic)



## SECTION 5: COOKERY

### Cyril Haydon Challenge Cup

- 37: Victoria sponge with raspberry jam filling and caster sugar topping (3 eggs, no bigger than 8")
- 38: Fruit crumble
- 39: Lemon drizzle cake
- 40: Favourite cake of your choice (no bigger than 9")
- 41: Best decorated cake (only decoration judged)



## SECTION 6: FLOWERCRAFT

### Broncroft Rose Bowl

- 42: Miniature arrangement in an unusual container no bigger than 4"
- 43: Arrangement of five roses, including foliage
- 44: Garden flowers in a basket (max 12" x 12")
- 45: Hand-held bouquet

Entrants must not have won a prize in the flower arranging section of the Autumn Show in the previous five years

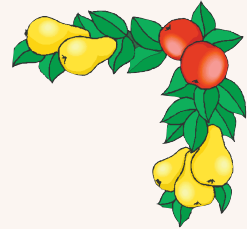
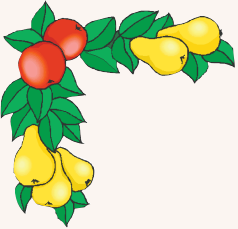


## SECTION 7: HANDICRAFTS

## RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1: All entry forms must be returned to the Entry Secretary /telephoned through or emailed by Tuesday, September 2 2025, unless otherwise stated.
  - 2: No person may enter more than one exhibit in the same class.
  - 3: Exhibits must be staged either between 7pm and 8pm on Friday September 5, or 8.30am to 10.30am on Saturday September 6, 2025.
  - 4: No exhibits or award cards may be removed until after the distribution of cups and prizes that will commence at 4.30pm.
  - 5: All exhibits must be grown or produced by the exhibitor. The Committee reserves the right to verify this. Only one entry per household for each section (except Spud in the Bucket).
  - 6: Root vegetables in Section 1 are to be exhibited with tops not exceeding 5".
  - 7: Although all possible care will be taken, the committee cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage.
  - 8: Exhibitors not complying with the rules will be disqualified.
  - 9: Points will be awarded thus – 1st = 3 pts, 2nd = 2 pts, 3rd = 1 pt.
  - 10: Any complaint must be made in writing to the Secretary within seven days.
  11. Decision of judges will be final in all matters; judges' comments are personal opinions.
  12. For hygiene reasons Cookery entries should be covered while on display.
  13. All cookery, preserves and beverages will be tasted.
- Points awarded will not be added into flowercraft section.
